for all of our campers.



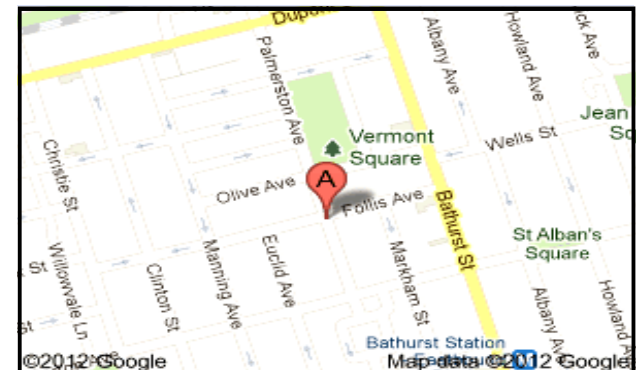
DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

- All children must be escorted to and from camp by persons 16 years of age or older
- Parents / guardians are required to sign their child in and out with staff. Information that needs to be relayed to staff can be discussed and documented at drop off and pick up time.
- If parents / guardians are picking up their child other than the normal pick-up time, please inform staff at the start of the day.
- Persons other than a parent / guardian may pick up a child only when prior verbal or written notice has been arranged. Photo ID of the alternate person will be requested at time of pick up.

- **Parents/guardians will be required to fill out all paperwork including immunization and medical history, parental contact information, emergency contacts, and sign field trip permission forms prior to commencement of camp.**
- **All forms can be picked up from the daycare office or from one of the school age staff.**
- **Any incomplete paperwork may result in your child not being able to attend camp on the first day of their registered week.**
